Overnight staff are responsible for ensuring a safe and secure environment for all shelter residents. Candidates should have a caring heart and be comfortable maintaining good boundaries while working with people in crisis.

A High School diploma or equivalent is required. Experience working in residential programs, client support, health and human services, or the medical field is a plus. We are looking for a team player with an excellent attitude, a desire to learn and grow, and a commitment to helping families learn to help themselves.
